Background

- Supporting families in Ayrshire for over 10 years •
- Funding from a variety of sources •
- 8 breastfeeding centres •
- Inspiring Scotland funding in Oct 2011 •
- Maternity unit, 6 week 1:1 peer support, breastfeeding • Make breastfeeding work for you! centres
- Training and supervision •

Support in Ayrshire

- Over the last two years
- 1500 mums in AMU and 15500 contacts
- 1200 mums 1:1 support and 15000 contacts
 - 7000 text messages, 6500 phone calls, 700 home visits
- 900 mums at Breastfeeding centres and 3000 contacts
- The BfN in Ayrshire had around 47 contacts a day supporting local mums

Current situation

- Inspiring Scotland funding ended April 2013
- Transition money from Scottish Government to 'support us in a transition to new funding or wind the project down'
- Keen to find other funding sources to enable the project to continue

Funding Search

- Local authorities and NHS approached
- Had some help from a professional consultant to produce a list of potential funders

Make breastfeeding work bor you!

- Grouped them into priority order
 - Closing dates
 - Best match
 - Amount available

Finding funding

- Trying to jigsaw together funding from different sources
- Using our experience to prioritise
- Centres and volunteers very important
- Training and supervision = sustainability
- Thinking differently about how we are funded and what differences our work can make

Applications

Since Jan 2013

- **BIG Early Intervention fund Unsuccessful**
 - All support in Ayrshire £180,000
- Weir Trust Unsuccessful •
 - All support in Ayrshire £200,000
- General funding request letters x 3 Not heard
 - Contribution to funding gap £1,000 or £2,000
- Local Authority grant Successful
 - £1500 to fund one breastfeeding centre
- Section 16b Successful
- Make breastfeeding work for you! • Support in the maternity unit £20,000 x 3 years

Applications

Since Jan 2013 (cont'd)

- Volant Trust Successful •
 - Focus on training/volunteering and helping women gain confidence
 - Three breastfeeding centres and helper training £20,000 x 3 years
- Public Social Partnerships x 2 Successful
 - Offering breastfeeding support as part of wider family support service – concentrating on vulnerable families
 - Partnership working Children 1st, Quarriers, Homestart, Barnados
 - £24,000 over 18 months
- Cattanach Trust Not heard
 - Make breastbeeding work for your 1:1 peer support and community work £18,000 x 3 years

Next steps

- So far have a mix of funding supporting different things and for different lengths of time
- Need to make sure all support can run in a joined up way but also independently
- Common threads volunteering, centres, training and supervision
