Islington's breastfeeding peer supporters, in their distinctive purple shirts, are all mums who have breastfed their own babies before having training to help other mums.

You may meet our team on the postnatal ward and will usually receive a phone call from us soon after your baby is born. You can also call or message us for support at any stage. If you can't access our virtual support or pre-booked in-person breastfeeding support options, we might also be able to visit you at home.

Our free service is open to all Islington families.
